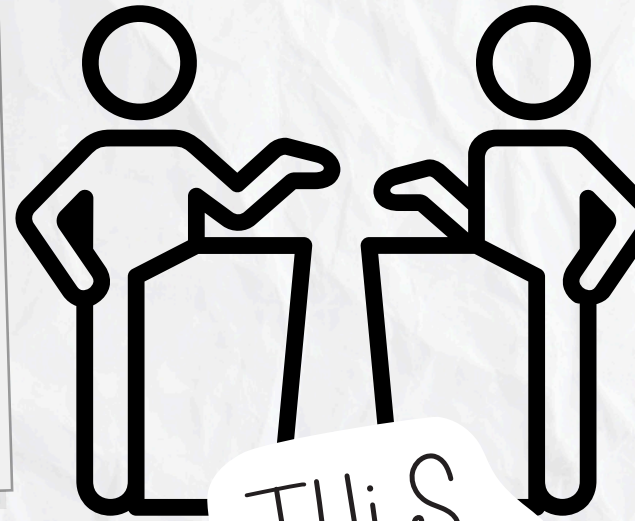

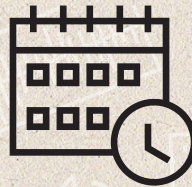

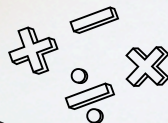

STUDENT SPOTLIGHT

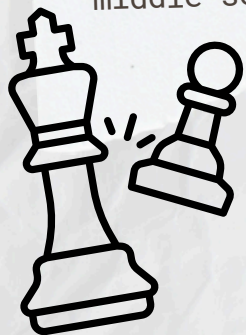


Aiden Fu

Student Tips for Success



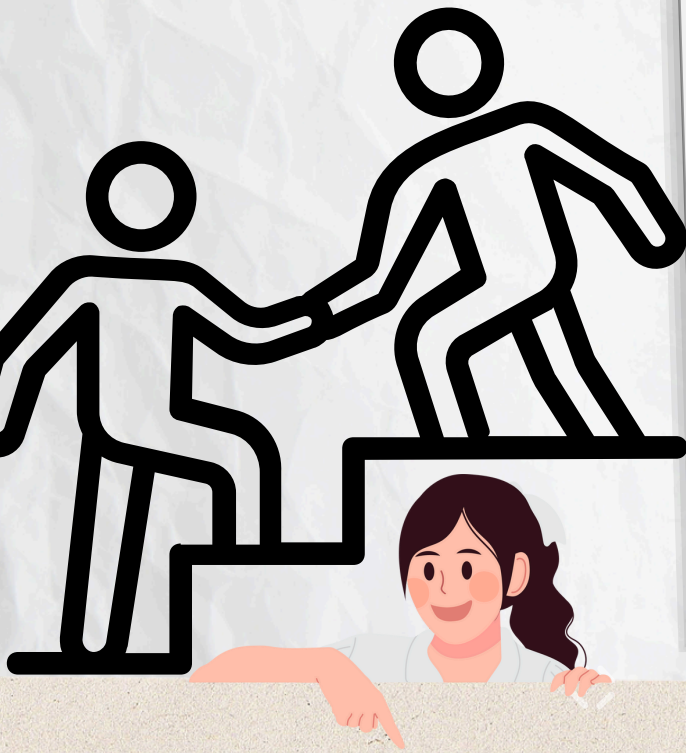
Listen Actively
