

• Use tools like the AREI model (Assertion, Reasoning, Evidence, Impact) to build clear and strong arguments

> Turn Nerves Into Power
> It's totally normal to feel nervous! Take 3 deep breaths before speaking, and remind yourself-your voice matters. Channel those jitters into energy that helps you shine. The more you practice, the easier it gets!
