Each day is thoughtfully divided into two focused blocks. Afternoons (1:00 PM–4:00 PM) introduce SPAR debate, where students practice quick-thinking, structured argumentation, and respectful rebuttal in a developmentally appropriate format.

Throughout the week, students gain confidence speaking in front of others, learn how to organize their ideas effectively, and develop the courage to express their thoughts with clarity. By the end of each session, students walk away with stronger communication skills and greater self-assurance, skills that extend far beyond the classroom.



## Middle School Camps (5<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup>)

Our Middle School Bootcamps are designed for students ready to take their communication skills to the next level. These intensive, week-long programs combine advanced public speaking instruction with structured parliamentary debate, providing students with the tools to think critically, speak persuasively, and engage confidently in academic discourse.

Each day is divided into two focused sessions. Mornings (9:00 AM–12:00 PM) are dedicated to TED-Style Public Speaking, where students research meaningful topics, craft compelling speeches, and refine their delivery through guided coaching and structured practice. Afternoons (1:00 PM–4:00 PM) focus on Parliamentary Debate, an impromptu debate format that challenges students to construct logical arguments, respond to opposing viewpoints, and think on their feet.

Throughout the week, students develop clarity of thought, confidence in presentation, and the ability to analyze complex issues from multiple perspectives. Throughout the week, students strengthen their ability to analyze complex topics, construct sophisticated arguments, and communicate with clarity and precision, skills that directly support success in high school coursework, competitive debate, college preparation, and beyond. Each day is divided into two focused training blocks. In the morning session, students develop extemporaneous speaking skills, learning how to quickly research, organize, and deliver well-structured speeches on current and meaningful issues. In the afternoon session, students transition into High School Parliamentary Debate, where they apply strategic argumentation, rebuttal techniques, and collaborative preparation in a dynamic, tournament-style setting. Every week features new resolutions and fresh content, allowing students to enroll in multiple sessions while continuing to grow and refine their skills. This intensive is offered weekly from June 1 through August 21, with enrollment available for morning, afternoon, or full-day participation.

Students debate timely resolutions, practice responding to opposing viewpoints, and experience the structure of tournament-style rounds.



# Online Summer Camps

Summer should allow flexibility for families, but it should not interrupt academic momentum. Our Online Summer Camp is designed for students who want to continue building high-level communication and critical thinking skills while maintaining the freedom to travel and enjoy their break. Through structured, live virtual instruction, students receive the same rigor, coaching, and accountability that define Cogito’s in-person programs.

All online courses are delivered in real time by experienced coaches in a focused, interactive setting. Students actively participate in discussions, drills, preparation sessions, and live simulations rather than passively observing. The environment is intentionally structured to ensure measurable growth in confidence, analytical reasoning, and persuasive communication. Each course is offered as a two-week intensive meeting Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM–12:00 PM. We offer multiple sessions throughout the summer, allowing families to select the dates that best align with their schedule. Because each session features new case material, resolutions, and practice rounds, students may enroll in more than one session and continue progressing. Our Online Summer Camp provides a balanced solution: flexibility for families and consistent academic advancement for students, no matter where summer takes them.

# Introduction to Parliamentary Debate



Our Online Parliamentary Debate prepares students for the fall competitive season through structured training, guided preparation, and live debate rounds. This two-week course is designed for both middle school and high school students and mirrors the principles of formal Parliamentary Debate competition. Students learn how to construct arguments for either side of a resolution, organize limited preparation time effectively, deliver structured speeches, and respond strategically through rebuttal. Because Parliamentary Debate is fundamentally an impromptu speaking format, students build adaptability, confidence, and analytical agility. Each two-week session focuses on new resolutions and tournament-style simulations, allowing students to enroll in multiple sessions while continuing to progress. The course is ideal for students preparing to join fall debate classes or seeking to strengthen their competitive foundation.



# PLATFORM SPEAKING

Grades: 8<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup>

Want to get a head start before the competitive season begins? Our Online Platform Speaking Bootcamp gives students the opportunity to develop, write, and refine a competition-ready speech before the 2025-2026 season officially starts. This course is designed for high school students preparing to compete in platform speaking events such as Original Oratory or Informative Speaking. Over the course of eight structured classes, students will learn the foundations of platform speaking, including topic selection, thesis development, research integration, narrative structure, rhetorical strategy, and delivery techniques. Students will move step-by-step through the speechwriting process, from brainstorming and outlining to drafting and revision, while receiving individualized coaching and detailed feedback. Emphasis is placed on crafting a clear message, building persuasive impact, and developing confident, polished delivery. By the end of the bootcamp, each student will have a completed, competition-level speech and a strong foundation heading into the fall season. The program runs for eight live online classes and offers two scheduling model options to accommodate different summer plans.

Participation in the Bridge Bootcamp is mandatory for all students who would like to join our club classes and is limited to students currently enrolled in our Intermediate Parliamentary program\* or incoming students with prior Parliamentary Debate experience\* who receive coach approval. This intensive online training experience prepares students for the pace, rigor, and expectations of competitive club debate, where members compete in over 15 tournaments at the middle school level and over 20 tournaments at the high school level each season beginning in early fall. At the conclusion of the bootcamp, students will be formally evaluated for acceptance and placement into the Debate Club.



The 2-week High School Club Bootcamp, available exclusively to current Cogito Debate Club students, provides 30 hours of rigorous preseason development. Students will sharpen advanced argument design, refine strategic round management, deepen impact analysis, and enhance high level refutation through intensive drills and practice debates. With over 20 tournaments each year, early and deliberate preparation is essential. Classes will be hybrid, however students are encouraged to join in person at our Irvine location.

# FAQ

**Q** What grade levels can enroll in summer camp?

**A** We offer summer programming for Elementary, Middle School, and High School students. Each division is structured to match students' developmental level, academic readiness, and communication goals.

**Q** What programs are available this summer?

**A** Elementary students participate in themed Public Speaking and SPAR Debate camps. Middle School students enroll in week-long Public Speaking and Parliamentary Debate bootcamps. High School students can participate in our week-long camp that focuses on Extemporaneous Speaking and Parliamentary Debate. We also offer Exclusive Bootcamps: Bridge Bootcamp for students seeking entry into Debate Club, Club Bootcamp for current Debate Club members, Online options including: Intro to Public Speaking, Parliamentary Debate, Platform Speech, and additionally Bridge and Club Bootcamps.

**Q** Are camps weekly or multi-week?

**A** In-person camps run weekly from June 8 through August 7. Students may enroll in one week or multiple weeks, as each session features a different theme or focus. Note there will be no camps June 29-July 4. Select online programs as well as Bridge and Club Bootcamps are two-week programs and must be completed in full. More details will be provided upon enrollment.

**Q** Can my child enroll in just the morning/afternoon camp?

**A** Yes! Families may choose morning (9:00 AM-12:00 PM), afternoon (1:00 PM-4:00 PM), or full-day enrollment depending on availability and preference.

**Q** My child has never done speech or debate before. Is that okay?

**A** Yes, for Elementary and open-enrollment Middle and High School programs. Beginners are welcome. Bridge Bootcamp requires current enrollment in our Intermediate Parliamentary program or prior experience with coach approval. Club Bootcamp is exclusively for current Debate Club students.

Q Are students grouped by age or skill?

A Students are grouped by division and experience to ensure appropriate pacing and challenge.

Q Will students get speaking experience?

A Yes! All programs include structured speaking opportunities, practice debates, and guided feedback.

Q Can students enroll in multiple weeks?

A Absolutely! Re-enrollment is highly encouraged, as each week features new themes, resolutions, or case material. This allows students to continue strengthening and expanding their skills without repetition while building greater depth and mastery over the summer.

Q Is lunch included?

A Lunch is included for students enrolled in our Full-Day program. Families enrolling in Morning or Afternoon sessions may purchase a weekly lunch option for \$75. Lunch is provided by Cogito and served on campus from 12:00 PM–1:00 PM.

Q What if I'm not sure which program is right for my child?

A We're here to help. If you are unsure which program best fits your child's experience level or goals, please reach out to our team. We're happy to provide guidance and ensure your student is placed in a program where they can feel confident, challenged, and supported..
